For those of you who did not get the chance to attend, many parents were shocked by the following figures which show just how important it is to hear your child read and to read stories to them at home.

Here's how many words children would have heard by the time they

were 5 years old:			
Never read to	=	4,662 words	
1-2 times per week	=	63,570 words	
3-5 times per week	=	169,520 words	The reading framework
Daily	=	296,660 words	Teaching the foundations of literacy
Five books a day	= 1	,483,300 words.	July 2021
