Mass Intention - If you would like to book a Mass Intention, please use the Mass Intention Envelopes available at the back of the church. The recommended Stipend by the Archdiocese for a Mass Intention is £10 for each Mass Intention.

With the Mass Intention diary filling up fast why not consider donating the sanctuary lamp that burns in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the Church in honour of a living or deceased loved one. Please place your donation of £10 in the special envelopes which are at the back of the church.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY - in the unlikely event that we need to empty the church in an emergency please make sure you are aware of the fire escape routes. One is located at the entrance door that you will have come through as you entered the church. The second is next to the Piety Stall. The third is located next to St. Joseph's Altar and the fourth is through the Sacristy and down the steps located next to the disabled toilet. If we need to evacuate, please do not leave, but rather gather on the club car park which is the assembly point.
