Feast of the Sacred Heart Friday 12th June - this is a very special day for our Parish. Why not celebrate with our parish school community and attend Mass in the School, (the entrance to the school is on Earlsbury Gardens) – you will be made most welcome.

Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School First Holy Communion will be celebrated at our 10.15am Mass on Sunday 28th June – Please remember the children and their families in your prayers.

Corpus Christi Procession – This Sunday 7th June Mass at 1pm will be celebrated at St Michael's Catholic Church, Moor Street (just off High Street, by the old Marks and Spencer). Everybody welcome. The procession then moves through the City Centre to St Chad's Cathedral. It is amazing to see the interest that people show, respectfully, as the procession moves through the City Centre. We would like everyone to consider joining this procession – something that would be familiar to many cultures around the world. As the procession arrives at St Chad's Cathedral, there are some moments of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. This procession is open to everybody, so please come and bring your family and friends.

The Sacred Heart & St. Margaret Mary Book of Remembrance has been produced for year-round display of deceased loved ones and is placed on St. Joseph's Altar. Names are entered alphabetically. The book will be updated annually – if the name of your loved one is not remembered in the book please speak to Teresa or Marie.
