

<b>Year 6</b>	<p><b>Steel Pans</b></p> <p>Developing Melodic phrases <i>How does music bring us together?</i></p> <p><b>Intent:</b> To copy back melodic patterns using the notes: D, E, F, G, A C, D, E, F, G, A, B G, A, B, C, D, E, F# D, E, F#, G, A, B, C# A, B, C, D, E, F, G</p>	<p><b>Steel Pans</b></p> <p>Understanding structure and form <i>How does music connect us with our past?</i></p> <p><b>Intent:</b> To identify the staff and symbols on the staff (such as the treble clef), the name of the notes on lines and in spaces, barlines, a flat sign and a sharp sign.</p>	<p><b>Steel Pans</b></p> <p>Gaining confidence through performance <i>How does music improve our World?</i></p> <p><b>Intent:</b> To identify the musical style of a song using some musical vocabulary to discuss its Musical Elements.</p>	<p><b>Steel Pans</b></p> <p>Exploring Notation further <i>How does music teach us about our community?</i></p> <p><b>Intent:</b> Explore standard notation, using dotted semibreves, dotted minims, minims, triplet crotchets, dotted crotchets, crotchets, dotted quavers, quavers and semiquavers.</p>	<p><b>Steel Pans</b></p> <p>Using chords and structure <i>How does music shape our way of life?</i></p> <p><b>Intent:</b> To improvise over a groove, responding to the beat, creating a satisfying melodic shape with varied dynamics and articulation.</p>	<p><b>Steel pans</b></p> <p>Respecting each other through composition <i>How does music connect us with the environment?</i></p> <p><b>Intent:</b> To create a melody using crotchets, quavers and minims, and perhaps semibreves and semiquavers, and all equivalent rests.
